WIAT-III Training is a two-day workshop that examines the administration and scoring of all subtests which comprise the WIAT-III. Day 1 covers general administration considerations as well as the specific demands of each subtest. Day 2 focuses on scoring the written response subtests as well as using the WIAT-III Scoring software to assess student essays. A one-hour webinar to answer any questions/concerns regarding WIAT-III administration will be available to participants on January 29, 2019 from 3:45 to 4:45. Participants are asked to bring a WIAT-III test kit and an unused copy of the WIAT-III administrator's booklet and student response booklet for use during the workshop.
